Information We Collect

We use different methods to collect information from and about you.

We collect personal information to provide you with services. We also collect personal information when you visit our website, platform, applications or contact us by email or via social media.

We collect the following types of information:

Personal Identification Information: Personal information or personal data means any information about an individual from which that person can be identified. It does not include data where the identity has been removed (anonymous data).

This may include your name, email address, postal address, phone number, your IP address etc., that you voluntarily provide to us when subscribing to our newsletter, creating an account, or contacting us through our contact forms.

The categories of personal information we may collect, use, store, and transfer about you, are as follows:

- **Identity data**, which includes your name, age/date of birth and gender, We also collect your job title, professional qualifications, work experience, organisational or institutional affiliations, or publications;
- **Contact data**, which includes postal address including billing and delivery addresses, your location, telephone numbers (including mobile numbers) and email address;
- **Special category personal data**, also known as sensitive personal data, which includes information about your physical or mental health, health conditions, general medical records, and boxing examination records;
- **Criminal Offence data**, this includes the results DBS checks in order to assess your suitability for within boxing
- **Transaction data**, which includes purchases and/or orders which are made by you and your payment card or bank transfer details;
- **Technical data**, which includes your online browsing activities on our website, our mobile application, our Platform, profile, and device information including IP address, browser type, version and language, identifiers associated with cookies or other technologies that may uniquely identify your device or browser;
- **Profile Data**, which includes your account login details for website and/or our online account, including your username and password(s), preferences, feedback, and survey responses;
- **Marketing and communications data**, which includes your marketing preferences from us and our third parties, your communication preferences, and your correspondence to and communications with us; and

- **other publicly available personal information**, including any which you have shared via a public platform (such as a Insta, X or public Facebook page).

How We Use Your Information

The law on data protection sets out a number of different reasons for which a company may collect and process your personal information.

We will only use your personal information when the law allows us to do so.

We collect and process personal information about our clients, customers, suppliers, subcontractors, stake holders, business partners or joint venture partners in order to carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered into and to provide you with the information, products and services that you request from us.

Examples of why we may use the information we collect for the following purposes:

- To register you for the boxing event.
- To manage and administer boxing participation in an event.
- To assess your fitness and eligibility to participate in the event.
- To ensure your safety and health during the event.
- To provide you and your clubs with information about an event.
- To verify your details or information in your application for an event either as a participant, volunteer or in any other capacity.
- To assess your suitability for working within a Boxing event either as a participant, volunteer or in any other capacity.
- To register for an event, including the purchase of tickets, fill out forms, or communicate with us.
- To process payments for tickets or other services.
- To analyse attendance and improve future events.
- To document the event for promotional, archival, and informational purposes.
- To use footage and images in marketing materials, social media, and other promotional activities.
- To ensure the safety and security of all attendees and participants.
- To provide you with information and services that you request from us
- To notify you about our events or offers
- To provide and improve our services.
- To personalise your experience on the website.
- To respond to inquiries and provide customer support.
- To send periodic emails about updates, promotions, or other information related to our services.
- To monitor and analyse website usage to improve functionality.

Lawful Basis for Processing Personal Information

The lawful basis that we most commonly use to collect and process your personal information are:

- Where you have consented before the processing.
- Where we need to perform a contract, we are about to enter or have entered with you.
- Where it is necessary for our legitimate interests (or those of a third party) and your interests and fundamental rights do not override those interests.
- Where we need to comply with a legal or regulatory obligation.
- Where it is necessary for your vital interests

In certain circumstances, we need your personal information to comply with our contractual obligations or to pursue our legitimate interests in a way which might be reasonably expected as part of our running our business and boxing events. For example, we need to use the information you provide us to enable us to deliver a boxing event.

Whenever you have given us your consent to use your personal information, you have the right to change your mind at any time and withdraw that consent. However, this will not affect the lawfulness of any processing carried out before you withdraw your consent.

Special Category Personal Data

We collect and process special category personal data and information about criminal convictions to verify your details, or information in your application, and / or in order to assess your suitability for the boxing event either as a participant or a volunteer.

If you are a participating boxer at an event:

We request health data and medical records from those participating in a boxing event to ensure your safety and health during the event, to assess your fitness and eligibility to participate in an event. We therefore may have access to your medical records relevant for your participation in boxing.

We also work with approved healthcare professionals to ensure yours and others safety throughout a boxing event.

We will collect special category personal data directly from you: When you register for an event, fill out forms, or communicate with us.

From approved medical professionals: When they provide us with your medical records relevant to your participation in boxing.

The lawful basis for collecting and processing your special category personal data based on the following legal grounds:

- Where you have given explicit consent for the processing of your medical and boxing medical history.
- Where the processing of the information is necessary to protect your vital interests during the event.

If you are volunteering at an event:

We request criminal offence data that is relevant and necessary for assessing the suitability of volunteers for the event. We will only collect criminal offence data that is relevant and necessary for assessing the suitability of volunteers for the event.

We will collect criminal offence data directly from you: When you register as a volunteer for an event, fill out forms, or communicate with us.

The lawful basis for collecting and processing criminal offence data is based on the following legal grounds:

- Where you have given explicit consent for the processing of any criminal offence data.
- Where the processing may be necessary to comply with legal obligations, such as safeguarding requirements.
- Where the processing may be necessary for your legitimate interests, such as ensuring the safety and security of the event.

On-line account and Platform

When you sign up to use our online services, or our volunteer platform, we require some of your personal information, including your name and contact details.

When you have a volunteer account you are able to access your account and update your personal information within our platform via your account settings and tools. By logging into your account and using your account settings, you can change your personal information. For instance, you can edit the profile data you provide. Please contact us if you would like your personal information removed from the system or deleted.

Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password that enables you to access certain parts of our platform, including our website, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. We ask you not to share a password with anyone.

Information Received from Third Parties

This is personal information we receive about you from third parties.

In addition to the personal information, you provide us directly, we may receive information and personal information about you from others, including:

Ticketing Platforms: Providing ticket purchase details.

Sponsors: Providing sponsorship details and related information.

Event Partners: For event management and promotional purposes.

Service Providers: Such as payment processors, IT service providers, and security personnel.

Medical Professionals: Providing medical records and health information.

Any data which is obtained from third parties will be kept in accordance this Privacy Policy, and with any additional restrictions imposed by the third party that shared your personal information with us.

How We Protect Your Information

We implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your personal data from unauthorised access, alteration, or destruction. This includes:

Encryption: Encrypting sensitive data.

Access Controls: Restricting access to authorized personnel only.

Regular Audits: Conducting regular audits to ensure data security.

However, please note that no data transmission over the internet is 100% secure.

Sharing Your Information

We do not sell, rent, or trade your personal information to third parties.

However, we may share your information with trusted third parties to perform certain functions on our behalf, such as hosting services, analytics providers, or marketing partners. These third parties are required to maintain the confidentiality of your data and comply with applicable data protection laws.

We may share your data with:

Approved Medical Professionals: For medical assessment and health monitoring.

Authorised Sporting Bodies: For verification and assessment purposes.

Event Organisers: To manage the event and ensure your safety.

Event Partners and Sponsors: For promotional purposes.

Service Providers: Such as media production companies and IT service providers.

Legal Authorities: If required by law or to protect our rights and interests.

Where personal information is shared with a managed service provider or other third-party suppliers, we work closely with them to ensure that your personal information is secure and protected at all times. We do not allow our third-party service providers to use your personal information for their own purposes and only permit them to process your personal information for specified purposes and in accordance with our instructions.

Our contracts with third parties make it clear that they must hold personal information securely, abide by the principles and provisions of data protection rules, and only use information as we instruct them to. In all instances where we disclose your information to third parties, we will ensure that your information is appropriately protected. If we stop using their services, any of your personal information held by them will either be deleted or rendered anonymous.

We may also disclose your personal information to comply with a regulatory or legal duty, or if it is necessary to disclose personal information in connection with an investigation of suspected or actual fraudulent activity or is based on a lawful disclosure request.

We may also disclose personal information where such disclosure is necessary to protect the safety or security of any persons, and/or otherwise as permitted under applicable law.

Marketing

We strive to provide you with choices regarding certain personal information uses, particularly around marketing and advertising.

If you have given your consent to receive marketing emails you can withdraw this at any time, or if we are relying on our legitimate interests to send you marketing you can object. In either case, just let us know. If you have received a direct marketing email from us and no longer wish to do so, the easiest way to let us know is to click on the unsubscribe link at the bottom of our marketing emails.

Your Rights

Under UK data protection law, you have the following rights regarding your personal data:

- **Withdraw your consent:** Where our processing of your personal data is based on your consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. If you do decide to withdraw your consent, we will stop processing your personal data for that purpose.
- **Right of Access:** You can request a copy of the personal data we hold about you.
- **Right to Rectification:** You can request that we correct any inaccuracies in your personal data or if the information is out of date or incomplete you can request it be changed. If you notify us that the Information, we hold is complete or inaccurate we will correct or complete the information as soon as possible.
- **Right to Erasure:** You can request the deletion of your personal data under certain circumstances including where we no longer have a reason for holding your Information, you withdraw your consent, or you object to its processing. Following your request, we will erase your Information without undue delay unless the continued retention is necessary and permitted by law.
- **Right to Restrict Processing:** You can request that we restrict the processing of your personal data in certain situations. This can be done in circumstances where we need to verify the accuracy of the information, if you do not wish to have the information erased or you have objected to the processing of the information, and we are considering this request. Once the processing is restricted, we will only continue to process your personal information if you consent, or we have another legal basis for doing so.
- **Right to Object:** You can object to our processing of your personal data for direct marketing purposes. In some circumstances you have the right to request that we temporarily stop using your Information in a certain way. This right applies where:

- you think the information we hold is inaccurate;
 - you think we are processing your Information illegally;
 - we no longer require your information, but you may require it for legal reasons; or
 - you have objected to us processing your Information (see below) and you await a response from us.
- **Right to Data Portability:** You have the right to receive a copy of your personal information which you gave to us. The copy will be provided in a commonly used and machine-readable format. You can also have it transmitted directly from us to another data controller, where technically possible.
 - **The right not to be subject to automated decision making and profiling:** You have the right to not be subject to solely automatic decisions (i.e., decisions that are made about you by computer without any human input) in relation to any processes that have a legal or similarly significant effect on you.

You will be notified if we make a solely automated decision which produces a legal effect or significantly affects you.

When you request to exercise your rights

You will not have to pay a fee to exercise any of the rights listed above. However, we may charge a reasonable fee if your request is clearly unfounded or excessive, including where requests are repetitive. Alternatively, we could refuse to comply with your request in these circumstances.

We may need to request specific information from you to help us confirm your identity and ensure your right to access your personal information or to exercise any of your other rights. This is a security measure to ensure that personal information is not disclosed to any person who has no right to receive it. We may also contact you to ask you for further information in relation to your request to speed up our response.

We try to respond to all legitimate requests within one month. Occasionally it could take us longer than a month if your request is particularly complex or you have made a number of requests. In this case, we will notify you and keep you updated.

Retention of Data

We will retain your personal data for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes outlined in this Privacy Policy, or as required by law.

In some circumstances we will anonymise your personal information (so that it can no longer be associated with you) for analytical or statistical purposes, in which case we may use this information indefinitely without further notice to you.

International Transfers of Data

Your personal information will be stored on systems with technical and organisational security measures and controls located within the UK.

Sometimes we will need to share your personal information with third parties and suppliers outside the UK such as Europe and the USA.

If we do this, we have procedures in place to ensure your personal information receives the same protection as if it were being processed inside the UK. For example, our contracts with third parties stipulate the standards they must follow at all times.

Any transfer of your personal information will follow applicable laws, and we will follow the guiding principles of this Privacy Policy.
